Town Council met in regular session, members present, Mayor Price, Councilmen J. R. Gier, G. S. Beeman, L. G. SHERBON, E. O. Eckland, and C. C. Belz.

Bills read. Moved by Sherbon and seconded by Beeman that bills be allowed and warrants be drawn for the same, carried.

Moved by C. C. Belz that the Mayor appoint a committee of two to cooperate with the committee from the commercial club in regard to the proposed gift of a city park by L. G. Sherbon, in order to present the same in a proper and legal manner for the consideration of the Council, seconded by Eckland, carried.

The Mayor appointed J. R. Gier and E. O. Eckland as that committee.

Committee that interviewed G. C. Hurlbutt, reported, and on motion of Council voted to propose the matter be settled by arbitration and the committee be continued, carried.

On motion moved that there be \$2000.00 from the sewer fund transferred to the water fund, also \$2000.00 from the bond fund transferred to the water fund. *carried*

Moved by Gier and seconded by Beeman that the treasurers report be accepted and filed, carried.
