Immediately upon adjournment of the old Council, the new Council met in regular session at the Town Hall.

On being called to order at 8:10 P.M. by the Clerk, the following Councilmen were present: Abbas, Brockway, Gravenstein, Hesselhuus, and Smith.

Absent: None.

Councilman Hesselhuus administered the oath of office to Calvin Crouse as Mayor of the Town of Conrad.

Mayor Crouse administered the oath of office to the five councilmen.

Moved by Brockway and seconded by Abbas that Clifford C. Belz be re-appointed Town Clerk for the ensuing year at a compensation of \$20.00 per month, payable quarterly. Carried.

Moved by Abbas and seconded by Hesselhuus that all regular meetings of the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad for the ensuing year be held on the first Monday of each month, at the Town Hall, at 7:00 P.M. Carried.

Moved by Hesselhuus and seconded by Abbas that Councilman Smith be appointed to serve as Weed Commissioner for the ensuing year. Carried.

Mayor Crouse, by and with the approval of the Council, appointed Dr. Geo. R. Gould to serve as Health Physician for the ensuing year.

Moved by Abbas and seconded by Brockway that the salary of the Health Physician for the ensuing year be set at \$10.00 per year, payable annually. Carried.

Mayor Crouse, by and with the approval of the Council, appointed the following standing committees to serve for the ensuing year, the first named on each committee to act as chairman:

WATER:	Abbas, Brockway, and Smith.

Moved by Gravenstein and seconded by Hesselhuus that the appointment of I. A. Cohen as Chief and Leonard Loverin as Assistant Chief, and the election of Arthur Prescott as a new member of Conrad's Volunteer Fire Department be approved and ratified by the Council. Carried.

Mayor Crouse, by and with the approval of the Council, appointed the following as members of the new Board of Trustees of the Free Public Library of the Town of Conrad:

Mayor Crouse appointed F. A. Prescott as Town Marshal for the ensuing year.

Moved by Brockway and seconded by Gravenstein that F. A. Prescott be appointed Night Watch for the ensuing year. Carried.

Moved by Gravenstein and seconded by Brockway that the compensation of the Town Marshal and Night Watch for the ensuing year be placed at \$70.00 per month, payable monthly, said compensation to include the care of the fire truck. Carried.

Mayor Crouse appointed Earl H. Poe as Water Superintendent and Street Commissioner for the ensuing year.

Moved by Abbas and seconded by Hesselhuus that the compensation of the Water Superintendent for the ensuing year be set at \$30.00 per month, payable monthly, with 40¢ per hour additional for labor as Street Commissioner. Carried.

Moved by Hesselhuus and seconded by Abbas that A. D. Curry's Pool Room License be renewed for another year at the same fees. Carried.

Moved by Brockway and seconded by Hesselhuus that Merchants Mutual Bonding Company's Bond #30180 for \$500. for Calvin Crouse as Mayor of the Town of Conrad, and their Bond #26104 for \$2,000.00 for J. F. Wheeler as Treasurer of the Town of Conrad, and Fidelity and

Casualty Company of New York's Bond #1682549 for \$500. for F. A. Prescott as Marshal of the Town of Conrad, all be approved and accepted by the Council. Carried.

Councilman Hesselhuus introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Gravenstein:

RESOLUTION NAMING DEPOSITORY OF  
PUBLIC FUNDS.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa:

That we do hereby designate the following named bank to be the depository of the town funds in amounts not to exceed the amount named opposite said designated depository and the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to deposit the town funds in amounts not to exceed in the aggregate the amounts named for said bank as follows, to-wit:

First State Bank, Conrad, Iowa:  
Maximum Deposit under this Resolution; \$10,000.00
