

August 26, 1996

The Conrad City Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. Answering roll call was Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Dorothy King, and Kevyn Zacharias. Absent: Kenny Sanderson. Also present were Helen Kopsa, Gary Moler and Matt Tapken, and Gary Sindelar. Mayor Gearhart presided.

Motion by King, seconded by Lutes to accept the clerks report for the month of July and place on file for audit. Ayes: 4.

King introduced a resolution transferring the balance of the the FY96 fire department budget, \$1598.24, to a fire department suppression fund. Lutes seconded and resolution #114-8.96 was adopted upon the following roll call. Ayes: Lutes, King, Zacharias, Mugge. Nays: none.


Mayor Gearhart will inform Bill Conrad that Council agreed to allow him to hook up to City water, but he would need to consult with Gary Moler about tapping into the line, being that Gary owns that particular line. Mr. Conrad could also run a separate line to the fire hydrant at his expense.

Council discussed briefly the water tower. Lutes informed Council that there seems to be some bubbling on the outside of the bottom of the bowl up to the letters about a quarter of the way around. Mayor Gearhart suggested getting someone with a crane to go up and investigate the bubbling.

Council then adjourned to the waste water treatment plant. They toured the plant with Gary Sindelar, Ryken Engineering, and also took a look at where a new facility could possibly be located. Council returned to Chambers at 8:10 p.m. Mayor Gearhart set a public hearing to be held on October 14, 1996 in Council Chambers, at 7:30 p.m. The purpose of the public hearing will be to discuss the expansion of the waste water treatment plant. Any interested parties are encouraged to attend this hearing to obtain information on this project.

With no further business apparent, Council adjourned at 9: 20 p.m.
