

July 21, 2003

The Conrad City Council met in special session on 07/21/03 in Council Chambers at the Conrad Municipal Building. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, LeAnn Lynch, and Steve Mugge. Absent: Bill Gearhart. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at twelve Noon.

Council acknowledged a letter received from the Grundy County Auditor stating that sufficient petitions had been filed calling for a Local Option Sales and Service Tax (LOSST) imposition. They then discussed the wording that would be placed on the ballot for the LOSST election that will take place on September 30, 2003. After consideration Lynch motioned to adopt resolution #107-7.02 as shown below. Mugge seconded the motion and roll was as follows: Ayes- Lutes, Lynch, Mugge, Callaway. Nays- none.

Resolution No. 107-7.02

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Conrad City Council requests that the Local Option Sales Tax Measure be placed on the ballot at a Special Election to be held on September 30, 2003, and that the following wording shall be placed on the ballot:

SHALL THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC MEASURE BE ADOPTED?

_____ NO

A local sales and service tax shall be imposed in the City of Conrad at the rate of one percent (1%) to be effective January 1, 2004.


Revenue from the sales and service tax are to be allocated in the City of Conrad as follows:

Fifteen percent (15%) for sewer operation and maintenance and eighty five percent (85%) for any lawful purpose of the City including but not limited to the Wolf Creek Child Care and Preschool, Inc. located in Conrad, Iowa and zero percent (0%) for property tax relief.

Passed and approved this 21st day of July 2003.

Council also determined that the poles should be open from 7 AM to 8 PM on the day of the special election. With no further business, the meeting was adjourned in a motion at 12:35 p.m.
