Also present was Helen Kopsa, Lisa Purvis, Shauna Callaway, Dorothy King, Rick Eckerman, and Joel Danielson. In the absence of Mayor Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

The City Clerk administered the Oath of Office to newly elected Officials; Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Lisa Purvis and Kenny Sanderson.


Joel Danielson and Rick Eckerman reported on the progress of the Bike Trail extension. They have been working on Right of Way easements and have signed agreements with JoAnn Klein and Mid Iowa Coop. They are still negotiating with Dan Kayser and Marty Probasco. The project is scheduled for bid opening on February 11, 2000.

City Clerk Hoy reported that the Code of Iowa chapter 398.2 will allow the terms and number of members on the Library Board to be changed only through a vote of the city at a regular city election. Council agreed to put the measure on the ballot of the next regular election if the Library Board so desires.

Motion by Weber, seconded by Sanderson to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with the Animal Rescue League for animal control measures. Ayes - 5.
