A Special Meeting was called at the Municipal Building at 8 P.M. by Mayor Martin.

Councilmen present: Bunn, King, Rowlison.
Absent: Gallentine, Metge

Purpose: Public Budget Hearing -

The Council was in session for one hour during which time no tax payer appeared, nor was there any objections to the budget filed in writing; whereupon it was moved by King, seconded by Rowlison that the Mayor and Clerk be instructed to certify the prop osed estimate and forward same to the County Auditor. Carried.

Motion by King that B.K.Wilhelm's application for a Garage Bldg Permit be accepted and approved according to specifications. Second by Rowlison. Carried. *Fee \$2.50 paid.*

Motion by King that R.H.Geise Class C Beer Permit be renewed. Second by Rowlison. Carried.

Grocery and Cafe Operators met with the Council and Mayor and set up ~~some~~ ground rules as a guide for the disposal of refuse and garbage.

Motion by Rowlison to adjourn. Second by King. Carried.

At a meeting of grocery store operators and cafe operators with the town council and mayor on August 5, 1964, the following ground rules were set up as a guide for the disposal of refuse and garbage.

1. In the burning of refuse it is hoped that a completely enclosed heavy wire burner be used. This type burner would eliminate flying embers and lessen the fire hazzard. Only paper, cardboard, crates and other inflammable items should be placed in the burner to burn. To try to burn garbage, spoiled fruits & vegetables in these burners only adds to an unsightly situation. The ashes from these burners should be cleaned out regularly.
2. It was agreed that garbage, spoiled fruits and vegetables and other such items that would tend to create an odoror draw flies, maggots and other insects be kept in two or more large garbage pails with lids.
3. Other refuse items such as bottles, cans and other containers be kept in a seperate container. Holes should be punched in containers used for this purpose so that stagnate water is not harbored.
4. Earl Morel has agreed to pick up refuse from the garbage pails and items from the other containers on MONDAY-WEDNESDAY & FRIDAY or SATURDAY of each week.

It is hoped that all businesses involved and their employees will comply with these arrangements as agreed upon those present at the meeting.
