The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 1-27-97 in Council Chambers. Members present: Robert Lutes, Ken Sanderson, Steve Mugge, and Kevyn Zacharias. Absent: Dorothy King. Also present Gary Sindalar, Engineer, Charles Friend, Correspondent, and Rick Penning, Grundy County Sheriff. Mayor Gearhart called the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m.

Motion by Sanderson, seconded by Mugge to approve the beer license for Conrad Casey's General Store. Ayes 4.

The contracts with Ryken Engineering, and Baumeier Construction on the sewer line and lift station in the Industrial Park, were table until the archeology survey has been completed.

Rick Penning requested \$40,000 for the fiscal year 97-98 to cover police protection. The contract includes a minimum of 180 hours a month of patrol time in Conrad. Council inquired about the theft of the lights from the bathhouse, and also requested that the on duty officer in town watch for illegal turning on Main Street.

The personnel committee made the following salary recommendations for the 97-98 fiscal year. Denise Hoy increase of \$1200 per year, Gary Moler increase of \$520 per year, Matt Tapken increase of \$3640 per year. No action will be taken on the recommendations, until the finance committee looks at the 97-98 budget more closely. A budget work session was set for Wednesday, February 5th at 7:00 p.m.
