On motion by Gould seconded by Clinite that H.D. Hunt be hired as clerk at a salary of four hundred dollars a year subject to his approval. carried.

On motion by Clinite seconded by Gould that Evelyn Stevens' bond as treasurer, and H.D. Hunt's bond as clerk be approved and accepted. carried.

On motion by Radloff seconded by Burch that Dr. R.T. Spain be appointed health officer at a salary of \$10.00 a year. carried.

On motion by Gould seconded by Martin that Keith Carlson's bond as plumber be approved and accepted. carried.

On motion by Gould seconded by Martin that Howard Burch be appointed weed commissioner. carried.

On motion and seconded that R.C. Dickover be appointed street commissioner and water superintendent for one year at the fixed salary of the past year. carried.

On motion by Gould seconded by Burch that Earl Morel's appointment by Mayor Gravenstein be accepted. The salary being \$150.00 per month. carried.

On motion by Martin seconded by Burch that the water meters of the town, hereafter be read quarterly. carried.

On motion by Gould seconded by Clinite that patrons with defected water meter be notified by the clerk to install new meters or repair old one. carried.

On motion by Clinite seconded by Gould that the First State Bank be named the depository for the town funds. carried.
