CONSENTING TO AND APPROVING PLANS FOR THE IMPROVE-
MENT OF THE EXTENSION OF COUNTY ROAD WITHIN CONRAD, IOWA.

WHEREAS Grundy County, Iowa, proposes to improve by grading and surfacing the extension of County Trunk Road "H" within the Town of Conrad, Iowa, in accordance with plans heretofore filed in the office of the Clerk of said Town of Conrad, Iowa, as follows:

Station 4/46.9 to Station 5/85.5 a distance of 1032.4 feet (1032.4 feet West of the East Corporation line of the Town of Conrad, Iowa) and, Whereas the Council has informed itself as to said improvement and has examined said plans therefor,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF CONRAD, IOWA:

1. That the said Town Council of Conrad, Iowa, hereby consents to the proposed improvement of the extension of County Trunk Road "H" within the Town of Conrad, Iowa, and

2. That the plans for said improvement as now on file in the office of the Clerk of said Town of Conrad, Iowa, are hereby approved, and

3. That said Council will take such legal steps and prosecute to a conclusion such legal action and/or proceedings as are now or hereafter may be required,

(a) To legally establish grade line of said Center Street in accordance with and as shown by the plans of said contemplated improvement hereinbefore approved.

(b) To prevent encroachment upon streets, highways and public grounds of said city upon which said County Trunk Road extension is now or may be hereafter located.

(c) To prevent erection of obstructions in said street, highways, and public places.

(d) To remove or cause to be removed obstructions erected therein.
