Town Marshall , Lisle Critser, was heard as to an adjustment of new salary for the ensuing year. For the time being his salary was raised to \$300.00 per Month, plus gasoline , and cents mileage when used in the performance of his duty as Marshall. However, if and when Town buys a car for Police Duty, he shall receive \$300.00 per month and car furnished, also gas while used for duty.

Members of the Council shall co-operate in trying to find a used car that will meet the situation.

Top suggested price was mentioned, but it was left open .

Meeting Con'td.

Council took up the matter as to the details as to the salary, and fringe benefite, of the new Street and Water Commissioner, namely Le Roy Miller.

His salary was placed at \$425.00 per month as earlier agreed.

Mr. Miller is also to act as Deputy Marshall.

× Mr. Miller si hereby given authority to employ extra man power when emergencies exist. He must keep detailed work sheet on persone so employed on any and all projects, where such man power and machinery is used, so as to render an accurate report on same, to Council.

Man and tractor with back hoe is to be paid no less than \$10.00 per hour and not less than \$10.00 per setting, when employed for private work for property owners.

Mr. Miller shall be on callduty seven days per week, and ifit is necessary for him to be off duty for emergency reasons, he shall, at his expense, employ an competant substitute.

A thirty day secerence notice must be given by either party.

One week's vacationwith pay shall be granted both the Commissioner and Marshall, after the first years employment and two weeks with pay after the second years employment; Such two weeks to be staggered by them so only one week will be taken by them at a time.

The Mayor called the attention to the fact that the newly appointed Street Improvement Committee wanted to meet with the Council at an early date.

It was suggested thatm this occur on Monday Evening Feb, 8th. 1960. Approved.

Motion made by Curry and seconded by Wilson that the meeting be advourned; so ordered and carried.
