ORDINANCE NO. 97  
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PLANTING, CARE AND TRIMMING OF TREES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

Be It Ordained By The Council of The Town Of Conrad, Iowa:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT:  
Ordinance Number 91 of the Ordinances of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, is hereby amended by adding to Section 2 thereof the following paragraph:  
The responsibility for care and control of all trees and shrubbery upon the public streets and the attendant duties of maintenance thereof is hereby conferred upon the abutting property owners of this municipality.

SECTION 2. REPEALER:  
All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE:  
This Ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
