#### ORDINANCE NO. 83

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 75 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A RESTRICTED RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT: TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION AND REPAIR OF ALL STRUCTURES OF ANY KIND WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE RESTRICTED RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT: TO ESTABLISH RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE AND OCCUPANCY OF SUCH STRUCTURES AND TO PRESCRIBE PENALTIES AND REMEDIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF SUCH RULES AND REGULATIONS AND REQUIRING PERMITS AND ESTABLISHING FEES THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa; Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 75 is hereby amended by adding the following described area to that portion of the Town of Conrad excepted from the application of the said ordinance, to-wit:

"all that area bounded by the east line of Hurlbutt's First Addition and Hurlbutt's Second Addition on the west, the south side of Center Street on the North, the north line of the railroad right of way on the south, and the west line of Lot Eight (8) of the County Auditor's Sub-division of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Eighty-six (86) North, Range Seventeen (17), West of the 5th P.M., on the east, EXCEPT that portion thereof situated north of the north line of Walnut Street extended and east of the east line of Alice Street Extended; also the South 168.5 feet of the said Lot Eight (8) of the County Auditor's Sub-division of the Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty-one (31), Township Eighty-six (86) North, Range Seventeen (17), West of the 5th P.M."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

#### ORDINANCE NO. 84

## ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SALARY ORDINANCE NO. 11, AS AMENDED, ENTITLES "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD, IOWA:

Section 1. Section 4 of said Ordinance No. 11, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following section enacted in lieu thereof:

"SECTION 4. Treasurer's Salary. The treasurer shall receive as compensation a salary of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars per year, payable quarterly; and in addition thereto, at the request of the treasurer, the town shall pay the reasonable expense of procuring the bond for the said treasurer, at a premium not exceeding one percent per annum of the amount thereof."

Section 2. Section 7 of the said Ordinance No. 11, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof;

"SECTION 7. Councilman Salary. Each councilman shall receive Three (\$3.00) Dollars for every regular or special meeting, but not exceeding, in the aggregate, the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five (\$125.00) Dollars per annum, which shall be paid in full compensation for all services of such councilman of every character connected with his official duties."

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
