

July 10, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 7-10-00 in Council Chambers. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lisa Purvis. Absent: Lloyd Weber. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., and began with a pledge to the Flag.

Rick Eckerman, Conrad Park Board, discussed with Council the opportunity to cost share a box scraper with the City to maintain the trail. The scraper could also be used on alley's. Rick will be checking with Bruce Marble on options available.

Building permits were: Chuck Friend, 8X16 deck, \$1425; Francis Kopsa, new home, \$142,624; Chad Miller, new home, \$180,000; Richard's Construction, new kitchen, \$11,000.

Brad Murty presented a slate for Black Dirt Days to Council. Parade route, street closing, electrical availability, mosquito spraying, and insurance were among the topics discussed. Motion by Lutes, seconded by Mugge to purchase additional liability insurance for the event. Ayes 4.

Council discussed, but took no action on the topic of sewer hookup expenses. Currently the property owner pays 100% of sewer hookups. Mayor Sanderson would like to see an ordinance change reflecting some sort of city cost share on sewer lines that are connected together instead of running directly to the main. Sanderson agreed to survey other cities as to their policies on this matter. Gary Moler will be asked to estimate how many sewer connections are tied together in town.

Steve Mugge and Shauna Callaway discussed recreational burning. It was the consensus of council to issue an annual permit for this type of burning. Residents should apply for their permits at the city clerks office.

Motion by Lutes, seconded by Mugge to approve a class C beer permit for Center Street Mini Mart. Ayes 4.

Motion by Purvis, seconded by Lutes to approve an outdoor application for Bogie and Bacall's for August 4th and 5th, 2000. Ayes 4.


