

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD IOWA. HELD AT THE TOWN HALL. IN THE TOWN OF CONRAD IOWA AT 7 30 O'CLOCK, P.M. ON THE 14" DAY OF JULY 1925.

Council Met on the above set out date pursuant to the official notice of the Mayor, which was in the following words and figures, to-wit: You are hereby notified that there will be a special meeting of the Town Council at the Town Hall in Conrad Iowa. on the 14" day of July 1925. at 7 30 O'Clock, P.M. for the purpose of considering the request of J L Parker, Trustee, for a franchise for the installation of a telephone system and the submission thereof to the electors of Conrad, Iowa, and for their approval or rejection.

and which notice was duly served upon and legally accepted by each and all of the members of said Council prior to the holding of said meeting.

The Mayor Called the Council to order, and on roll call the following councilmen were present; J R Gier, C C Belz, H E Frederick Whereupon, the Mayor announced the object of the meeting.

R L Parker, Trustee, then presented an ordinance granting him, his successors or assigns, a franchise for the installation of a telephone system in the Town of Conrad, Iowa. as recorded at the end of these minutes and included herein.

Whereupon, Councilman Belz, introduced said Ordinance No. 61 and entitled an ordinance authorizing R L Parker, Trustee, his successors or assigns, the right to the use of the Streets, alleys, Highways, and public Places of the Town of Conrad, Iowa. for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and operation of a telephone system, both ~~and~~ local and long distance, for a period of twenty-five years, and moved ~~that~~ that it be placed up on its first reading; which motion was seconded by Prescott on roll call the following councilmen voted Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, voted, Nay, None.

Said motion having received the number of votes required by law was then declared to have been duly passed and adopted and said ordinance No 61, was then read the first time.

It was then moved by Gier, and second by Frederick, that the statutory rule requiring an ordinance of a general or ~~character~~ permanent character and those for the appropriation of money. to be fully and distinctly read on three different days, be dispensed with. and that Ordinance No, 61, entitled, an ordinance authorizing R L Parker, Trustee, his successors or assigns, the right to use of alleys, Streets, Highways and public places of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, for the Construction, Re-Construction, Maintenance and operation of a Telephone System, Both Local and Long Distance, for a Period of Twenty-Five Years, be placed upon its second reading. upon roll call the following Councilmen Voted Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, Nay, None. The motion having received the legal and statutory majority was declared to have been duly passed and said ~~the~~ Ordinance placed upon its second reading and read.

Thereupon, it was moved by Crouse, and second by Gier, that the statutory rule requiring an ordinance of a General or permanent nature and those for the appropriation of money, to be fully and distinctly read on three different days, be dispensed with, and Ordinance No, 61 entitled, an Ordinance authorizing R L Parker Trustee, his successors or assigns, the right to the use of the Streets, Alleys, Highways and Public Places of the Town of Conrad Iowa. for the construction, Re-construction, maintenance and Operation of a Telephone system, both ~~and~~ local and Long Distance, for a period of Twenty-Five Years, be passed to its third ~~reading~~ and final reading, on roll call the following Councilmen voted Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, Nay, None. and said motion having received the legal majority of votes was Declared to have been duly adopted and said Ordinance was then placed upon its third and final reading and read.

Whereupon, it was moved by Frederick and second by Prescott, that Said Ordinance No, 61 entitled an Ordinance authorizing R L Parker Trustee, his successors or assigns, the right to the Streets, Alleys, Highways and Public places of the Town of Conrad, Iowa. for the Construction, Re-Construction, maintenance and operation Of a Telephone system, Both Local and Long Distance, for a Period of Twenty-Five Years, was passed and adopted, on Roll Call the following Councilmen Voted, Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, Nay, None.

and said motion having received the legal majority of said votes was declared to have been duly and legally adopted, and said Ordinance duly passed and adopted.

It was then moved by Prescott, and second by Crouse, that a special Election be called to be held on the 19th day of August A.D. 1925. at Conrad Iowa. at 8 O'clock A.M. of said date, at which time the said Ordinance No 61, will be submitted to the electors of the Town of Conrad, Iowa. for their approval or rejection, and that said Election be held at the following place, to-wit; The Town Hall. and that Judges and Clerks of the Election be appointed as by Law provided with reference to general City Elections. the following members of the Council Voted Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, Members Voting Nay, None.

and said motion having received the necessary number of Votes required by law declared to have been duly passed and adopted.

Thereupon, Councilman Crouse. and second by Prescott, moved that the Mayor and Clerk be authorized, directed and instructed to prepare a and caused to be published the necessary legal notice of said Election and to make all necessary arrangements for the holding of said Election, as by Law provided, including the securing of ballots and Election supplies. the following members of the Council Voted Yea, Gier, Belz, Frederick, Prescott, Crouse, Members Voting Nay, None. ~~and the following members~~

and said motion, having received the necessary number of Votes, as required by Law, was declared to have been duly passed and adopted.

ORDINANCE No 61.

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO R L PARKER, TRUSTEE, HIS SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS, THE RIGHT TO THE USE OF THE STREETS, ALLEYS, HIGHWAYS and PUBLIC PLACES OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD, IOWA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A TELEPHONE SYSTEM, BOTH LOCAL AND LONG DISTANCE, FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY FIVE YEARS. Be it Ordained by the Mayor and Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa.

Section 1. The right is hereby granted to R L Parker, Trustee, his successors or assigns, to erect, maintain, operate and use its poles, wires, cables, and other fixtures necessary or convenient, upon, over, or under the streets, alleys, highways, and public places of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, under the provisions of this Ordinance,

Section 2. the location of all poles, wires, cables, and other fixtures, shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Council of the said Town, or its duly authorized committee, and shall be so placed and maintained as not to interfere with the ordinary public travel, and shall be subject to all regulations now existing or hereafter enacted by said Town.

Section 3. the rights herein granted shall not be exclusive and the Town of Conrad, Iowa, expressly reserves the right to grant similar privileges to other persons, firms or corporations,

Section 4. in consideration of the granting of this Ordinance the said R L Parker, Trustee, grants to the Town of Conrad, Iowa
a.---the rights to use the Company's poles for the purpose of stringing wire for fire alarm purposes, such construction to be done under the supervision of the Company and done in such manner as not to interfere with the convenience of said company in maintaining its lines, and.
b.--- the maintenance of a continuous twenty-four hour daily service,
c.--- the installation and service of a free telephone in the Town Hall for local and rural calls only.

Section 5. this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after its publication in the Conrad Record, its approval by the voters of Conrad, Iowa, as by law provided, and the Payment of the expenses connected herewith, by the said R L Parker, Trustee, and shall remain in force and effect for a period of twenty-five Years.

Section 6. the question of granting this franchise shall be submitted to a vote of the people of Conrad, Iowa, at a special Election to be held on the ~~19th~~ ^{19th} day of August, 1925, and the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and instructed to

Section 7. all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
