

November 26, 2001

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 11/26/01 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll call was Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Shauna Callaway. Absent: Lloyd Weber. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order and began with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 p.m.

Council member Mugge introduced a resolution amending resolution number 126-12.00 and terms of the Urban Renewal Tax Increment Revenue Bond, Series 2000. Mugge motioned to adopt resolution #136-11.01 amending resolution #126-12.00, Lutes seconded and roll was as follows: Ayes: Gearhart, Callaway, Mugge, Lutes. Nays: none.

Council member Mugge motioned to approve a beer license for Conrad Foods, seconded by Callaway. Ayes: 4. Nays: 0.

Mayor Sanderson updated council on various projects. The seeding on Duesenberg Drive and Maple Avenue will not take place until next spring, and he also discussed approaches off of Maple Avenue. They will have Gary Sindelar take a look at these.

Council agreed to hire BDL by the hour to move around some dirt and concrete at the concrete dumpsite north of Packaging Corporation.

Council was reminded that the December 10th meeting will be held at the Oak Estates Dining room, and that the December 24 meeting will be cancelled.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 7:30 p.m.
