All located on Center Street between Alice Street and Lincoln Street, And on Lincoln Street between Center St. and Grundy Ave, in said Town Filed with the town clerk in accordance with the terms of the published notice calling for proposals for the construction of said improvements, be and the same is hereby accepted,

The bid of said Paul Berg, being the lowest legal bid received.
