April 12, 1961

The Town Council met in special session at 7:00 P.M. at the Municipal Building. On call to order by Mayor W. W. King the following members were present: Wilson, Curry, Koehler, Manning. Absent: Daggett

The first action taken by the town council was to vote upon the passage of the Ordinance entitled:

AN ORDDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION AND LICENSING OF DOGS? PROHIBITING DOGS FROM RUNNING AT LARGE? PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING OF DOGS AND REDEMPTION THEREOF BY THE OWNERS? PROVIDING FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF CERTAIN DOGS UNDER PRESCRIBED CONDITIONS?: AUTHORIZING CONTRACT FOR IMPOUNDING, COLLECTION AND DESTRUCTION OF DOGS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

(This ordinance is found in the Ordinance Book #86.)

Motion by ~~Keebler~~-Curry, seconded by Koehler to adopt dog license. Carried.

Next action taken by council was to determine price to be paid for a tract of land being bought from Quentin Carnes. After a discussion of such, the following motion was made by Wilson; and seconded by Manning;

that the town enter into contract for the purchase of east 66' of Q. Carnes property for \$900.00 and that the clerk be authorized and directed to execute the contract on behalf of the town. Carried.

Motion by Koehler, seconded by Manning to adjourn. Carried.
