

November 27, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 11/27/00 in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Sanderson. Answering roll call was Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lisa Purvis, and Lloyd Weber. Shauna Callaway arrived at 7:10 p.m.

Tina Hamilton, Grundy County Development Alliance, spoke to Council about the upcoming Leadership Academy. Deadline to register is January 22, 2001 with a registration fee of \$119.00. Council agreed to partially sponsor Shauna Callaway and possibly one other person from Conrad.

Betty Wood visited with Council about Museum Board appointments. After discussion, Purvis motioned to appoint a Council liaison to the Museum Board instead of an actual position on the Board. Mugge seconded. Ayes 5.

Council discussed a bid from Hydro-Kleen to televise and clean certain sewer lines in Conrad. No action was taken.


Council considered a resolution supporting the current bottle bill as requested by Grundy County Engineer, Gary Mauer. Purvis agreed to look into any proposed amendments to the bill so that Council could make a decision of support knowing all options available. No action was taken.

Motion by Weber, seconded by Purvis to approve the renewal application for a beer permit for Conrad Foods. Ayes 5.

Motion by Purvis, seconded by Mugge to set a public hearing for December 11, 2000 at 7:40 p.m. on the issuance of \$190,721 Urban Renewal Tax Increment Revenue Bonds for the purpose of paying an economic development grant to Oakveiw, Inc., with respect to the construction of Oak Estates, an assisted-living facility. Ayes: Lutes, Purvis, Mugge, Callaway, Weber.

Purvis motioned and Mugge seconded to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m. Unanimous.
