The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 11-08-99 in Council Chambers. Answering roll call was Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lloyd Weber, and Kevyn Zacharias. Kenny Sanderson arrived at 7:15 p.m. Also present was Denise Hoy, Don Kleibenstien and Lisa Purvis. Mayor Bill Gearhart called the meeting to order at 7:04 p.m.

Minutes from the 10-11-99, and 10-25-99 were approved as published. Motion by Weber, seconded by Zacharias to approve the clerks report and place on file for audit. Ayes 4. Motion by Lutes, seconded by Zacharias to approve the following bills and draw warrants upon the same. Ayes 4.

Weber motioned and Sanderson seconded to adopt resolution #129-11.99 placing a street light at the corner of Alice Street and Oak Street. Ayes: Lutes, Mugge, Sanderson, Zacharias, Weber.

Mayor Gearhart appointed Kenny Sanderson to serve on the 911 Emergency Board.

Sanderson motioned and Mugge seconded to approve the liquor license for the Conrad Grove Recreation Club. Ayes 5.

Motion by Sanderson, seconded by Mugge to adopt resolution #130-11.99, an easement between Dick and Nancy Woodley and the City of Conrad for a water line on the east side of Koehler Mobile Home Park that will run to the new sewer plant. Ayes: 5.

Lutes motioned and Weber seconded to adopt resolution #131-11.99 authorizing the mayor and the clerk to sign the request for voluntary annexation of the real estate that is part of the new sanitary sewer facility being constructed. Ayes: 5.

Council instructed the City Clerk to issue a check for \$30,000.00 to the Kliebenstein Trust Account for the purchase of the Huntley home. The Raskel Fund of \$14,277.60 and T.I.F. money is to be used for this purchase.

Fred Leytham, Alliant Energy, presented council with some ideas on street lights for Main Street. He suggested they put a total of 19 light on Main Street from Grundy Street to the South Main Street Bridge. Leytham will have price quotes at the next regular meeting. Council discussed putting a new water line down Main Street, and installing a storm sewer on the west side of Main in conjunction with the street light project. No decision was made at this time.


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Council discussed the water drainage from the new storm sewer into the Wolf Creek. Weber will instruct Bruce Marble to use the maintainer to cut a section of dirt out where the outlet dumps.

Council discussed the policy on sewer line connections. They reaffirmed that it is the property owners responsibility and expense to hook into the sewer main.

With no other business, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 8:55 p.m.
