The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 3-13-00 in Council Chambers. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Lisa Purvis. Lloyd Weber arrived at 7:10 p.m. Don Kliebenstein arrived at 7:25 p.m. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Minutes from the 2-14-00, and 2-28-00 were approved as published. Motion by Callaway, seconded by Mugge to approve the clerks report and place on file for audit. Ayes 4. Motion by Lutes, seconded by Mugge to allow the following bills and draw warrants upon the same. Ayes 4.

Motion by Mugge, seconded by Weber to enter into contract with Sheets Excavating, Ltd. of Montezuma, Iowa, in the amount of \$48,956.35, for the Comet Trail extension. Ayes: 5.

Building permits were as follows: Paul Hefty, reconstruct porch, \$13,500; Gary Steinfeldt, reconstruction and addition, \$5,000; John & Julie McNair, 42 X 101 commercial building, \$93,000.

Change orders on the sewer plant were tabled.

Motion by Purvis, seconded by Mugge to approve the following salary recommendations: 5% increase for Denise Hoy; 70 cent per hour increase for Bruce Marble; 40 cent per hour increase for Gary Moler. Ayes 5.

Motion by Weber, seconded by Mugge to renew the burn site lease with Bob and JoAnn Klein for a two year period. Ayes 5.

Mayor Sanderson opened the budget hearing at 7:34 p.m. With no written or oral objections, Lutes moved to adopt the Fiscal Year 2001 budget for the City of Conrad, Iowa. Mugge seconded and roll was as follows: Ayes- Weber, Callaway, Mugge, Purvis, Lutes. Nays- none.

Council discussed at length the street lights and sidewalks on Main Street. Fred Leytham presented a contract for design work on the project. Council did not approve the contract until changes they negotiated have been made. They also discuss assessments for the project, however no action was taken.

Meeting was adjourned by Purvis, seconded by Callaway at 8:37 p.m. Ayes 5.
