June 21, 1943

Council met in special session at Town Hall; On being called to order at 7:00 P. M. by Mayor Belz, the following members were present: Berry, Brockway, Clinite, Gravenstein, and Larson. Absent, None.

Councilman Brockway introduced the following Resolution, and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Gravenstein.

"BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE INCORPORATED TOWN OF CONRAD, GRUNDY COUNTY, IOWA.

That all of the streets and avenues within the corporate limits of the town are hereby ordered oiled and the entire costs thereof, except the expense of oiling the intersections, shall be assessed to the abutting property according to the benefits conferred thereby. The oiling to be done by the Municipality and the benefits assessed in accordance with the state law providing for the oiling of streets and assessing the costs to the abutting property benefited."
