The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gearhart at noon at the Country Inn.

Cliff Wilson introduced John Pollard of TSP Six, Inc., an architectural firm in Marshalltown. Wilson stated he had met with two other architects but felt Pollard and his firm could serve our needs better than the others.

King made the motion to accept Cliff Wilson's recommendation to hire the firm of TSP Six, Inc. to design the City Hall/Heritage Center. Second by Lutes. Carried unanimously.

Wilson also felt it would be good to add four people to the Historic Preservation Commission during this phase. He recommended Verne Reece, Ken Hoff, Phyllis Pies and Dale Smith (Beaman).

Lutes made the motion to accept Wilson's recommendation to appoint Verne Reece, Ken Hoff, Phyllis Pies and Dale Smith to a twelve month term on the HPC. Second by King. Carried unanimously.

The group discussed the new building with Pollard. His firm would like a plat of the two lots showing the buildings, curb, walks, trees, width of alley and utilities. Moler and Adelmund will be asked to do this. They will also find the lot pins, bring them up and flag them.

Motion to adjourn by Sanderson. Second by King. Carried unanimously.
