A motion was made by Gearhart and seconded by Weber to adopt resolution #128-9.01 "In Support of the Marshall County Municipal Mutual Aid Agreement". Ayes: Weber, Gearhart, Callaway, Mugge, Lutes. Nays: none.

Motion by Mugge seconded by Callaway to sign up for DLS "Light Net" through Heart of Iowa Communications for City Hall. Ayes: 5.

Council set Trick or Treat for Wednesday, October 31, 2001 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. for the City of Conrad. Council also extended the City limb pickup for Conrad through the month of October.

With no further business, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 8:40 p.m.
