

ORDINANCE NO. 80

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE LOCATION OF STOP SIGNS AT THE ENTRANCE TO CERTAIN STREETS IN THE TOWN; ESTABLISHING RULES AND REGULATIONS: AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

Be it Ordained by The Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa.

SECTION 1. Location of Stop Signs designated. Stop signs shall be placed at the following street intersections:

(a) At all streets or alleys meeting or intersecting Main or Center Streets, thereby requiring any vehicle approaching Main Street to stop before entering Center Street or Main Street.

(b) At all corners of the intersection of School Street and Grundy Avenue except the northeast corner thereof, thereby requiring any vehicle approaching that intersection, except a vehicle approaching School Street on Grundy Avenue from the East, to stop before entering the intersection.

SECTION 2. Stopping before entering intersection. The driver of a vehicle shall bring the said vehicle to an absolute stop at the entrance to an intersection where a stop sign has been erected pursuant to this ordinance and shall yield the right-of-way to other vehicles which have entered the intersection from any other direction; but the driver having stopped and so yielded may proceed with caution and with due care enter said intersection.

SECTION 3. Exception for Emergency Vehicles. The driver of an authorized emergency vehicle when responding to an emergency call upon approaching such a stop sign shall slow down as necessary for safety but may proceed cautiously past such stop sign. At other times drivers of authorized emergency vehicles shall stop in obedience to such a stop sign.

SECTION 4. Penalties. Anyone violation any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
