

Special Council Meeting,

Purpose of the meeting was to meet with the Street Improvement Committee, appointed by the President of the Commercial Club.

It was moved and seconded that the Town of Conrad purchase a 1954 Plymouth from the Fridays Service to use as a Patrol car for the Safety department for the policing the Town of Conrad.

The purchase price of same to be \$500.00, and the Town Clerk was ordered to issue warrant for the payment of same.

The Town Clerk was also asked to that the title & other particulars in the ownership of same be taken care of as well as therefunding of license fee on it.

On order of the Mayor and council the Town Clerk was authorized to write the Mosely Imp. Co in regard to the nuisance created for the Street Department by having machinery placed as to interfere with the movement of Town equipment, which has to be moved in and out of the Town Garage.

The balance of the meeting was consumed by a long discussion of the Street Improvement problems.

The discussion was enlightening and healthy at all times, and every angle as to ways, and means to do the job.

Ways of how property owners and the Town should or could share the financial structure were weighed carefully so as to make it logical for all parties concerned.

A final work sheet was finally agreed upon and the committee will go out and contact the property holders on the basis agreed upon,

After their canvas another meeting will be held for further discussion and to formulate complete plans.

Mr. Clapsaddle will be retained as the engineer and will get facts and figures in event the project is off to actual starting point.
