ORDINANCE NO. 112
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS.

Be It Ordained By The Council Of The Town Of Conrad, Iowa:

SECTION 1. COUNCILMEN.

The salary of each councilman shall be \$15.00 for each regular and \$16.00 for each special meeting of the Council, effective as of January 1, 1972. Prior to January 1, 1972, the salary of each councilman shall be \$3.00 for each regular and special meeting of the Council. Salaries of councilmen shall be paid quarterly.

SECTION 2. MAYOR.

The salary of the Mayor shall be \$400.00 per annum, to be paid in quarterly installments, effective as of January 1, 1972.

SECTION 3. TREASURER.

The salary of the Treasurer shall be \$200.00 per annum, to be paid in quarterly installments, effective as of January 1, 1970.

SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

Ordinance No. 11, Ordinance ~~100-01 and all~~ amendments to said Ordinances, and all other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.

A Committee composed of one Councilman from each town, one Trustee from each township and the Board of Supervisors to meet in Jan. 1970.

Leo Miller wishes to purchase the SE extension of Church Street, approximately 4800 sqft.

Motion by Miller, second by Friday to sell Leo Miller this portion of land for \$ 250.00 and the Town assume the survey and quit claim deed expense. Carried.

Kliebenstein to draw up an Ordinance for same.

Motion by McLean that the Marshall be authorized to suspend live entertainment license if he sees fit. Second by Metge. Carried.

Motion by Metge to purchase a sawed off shot gun to be used in the Police Car. Second by McLean. Carried.

Motion by Friday to accept the application for a Class C Liquor License for Richard Brennecke at Sit & sip. Second by McLean. Carried.

Motion by Friday to renew the license for a Pool table, Dancing, and Live Music to Helen Jean Ferris at Jean's Tap. Second by Metge. Carried.

Meeting was adjourned.
