

July 22, 2002

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 7-22-02 in Council Chambers. Answering roll call was Robert Lutes, LeAnn Lynch, and Steve Mugge. Absent: Shauna Callaway, Bill Gearhart. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Council discussed the codification of the City Code of Ordinances. They will report back to the City Clerk by Monday July 29, with any changes they desire to be made.

The City Clerk was instructed to send the Housing Rehab Grant informational letter and application to every citizen in Conrad. Letters and applications will be mailed in the next week or so.

Council discussed traffic control, specifically illegal turns, on Main Street from Grundy Ave to Center Street. They are considering signing and enforcement. No action was taken.

Lutes motioned and Mugge seconded to adopt resolution #118-7.02 "Accepting the Fiscal Year 2002 Street Finance Report". Ayes: Mugge, Lynch, Lutes. Nays: none.

Robert Lutes reported that he and Gary Sindelar had met with the BCLUW School Board and discussed the options for storm water run off from their parking lot. The Board indicated that they had in their plans to replace the parking lot and that would resolve the drainage issues. They also indicated that they might be able to move the project head, depending on financing, so that the drainage issues could be addressed more timely.

Sindelar reported that he had contacted BDL in regards to the intake, curb and gutter in front of Casey's and the curb and gutter in front of the Library. He will get quantities and estimates for the next regular meeting

With no further business, meeting was adjourned by motion at 7:20 p.m.
