Mayor Gearhart, Bob Lutes and Verne Reece met with the Beaman City Council, First Responders and Don Kliebenstein at 7:00 P.M.


Steve Metge explained that the Beaman-Conrad First Responders were organized as a volunteer emergency group to respond to medical emergencies. Since they began in April they have responded to twenty five calls.

The group has no way to obtain insurance unless they have a rescue vehicle. They are covered by the Good Samaritan Law but if taken to court someone would have to pay the attorney fees.

The solution was to become part of the Beaman and Conrad fire departments, setting up a committee with elected officials under each department. This way the group would be covered under the city insurance policies.

There will be one bank account with either the Beaman clerk or the Conrad clerk writing checks and doing the book work.

The Beaman and Conrad city councils at previous meetings have already accepted the First Responders with the stipulation that they be under the fire departments, now each fire department needs to change their by-laws to accept the First Responders.
