Motion by Friday that bills be allowed and warrants drawn. Seconded by Morrison. Carried.

Mrs. Jerry Johnston represented the Plan Commission and gave their report, stressing their concern about the water facilities in Conrad. They suggested the Town seriously consider constructing a 200,000 gal. elevated water tank.

Mr. Phillip Thorp of the D.C. Taylor Co., Cedar Rapids presented a new water tower Maintenance contract to the Council for their consideration. The present contract expires this year. The proposal was turned over to the water committee until the old contract could be read and comparison made.

An application for a Class B beer permit by the American Legion was approved with a motion by McLean, seconded by Morrison. Carried.

Att'y Kliebenstein sent Ordinance#112 to the Council, complete and ready to be signed, sealed and delivered before Jan.1,1970. This ordinance pertains to salary increases of the Town Officials. Action was deferred on this ordinance until a later date.

Copies of a land survey prepared by Clapsaddle- Garber Associates, Conrad, Iowa of Lot 1 Block 4, Conrad Grove Addition, were handed to each Council member. Boundary lines were discussed. It was also brought to the attention of the Council by McLean of an alley in Town being only 4 feet wide. Council discussed buying the additional 12 feet.

Clapsaddle Garber Associates also made a report regarding South Main Street Bridge repairs. Action was tabled until a representative of the engineering firm could be present to discuss the report.

Councilman McLean reported that the Town should have a standard water deposit plus a turn on and turn off charge to be paid by renters or owners of properties. A fair figure would have to be set and Att'y Kliebenstein should be consulted about an ordinance being made for this proposal.

LeRoy Miller was instructed to put anti- freeze in town equipment for winter.

Motion by Friday to adjourn, seconded by McLean. Carried.

A Special Meeting was called by Mayor Martin for 7:00 P.M. at the First State Bank. Councilmen present: Friday, Metge, McLean, Morrison. Absent: Miller.

Motion was made by McLean that the Schroeder Const. Co. Griswold, Iowa be paid for the installation of 760 feet of 4 inch plastic water main @ \$ 1.30 per foot for a total of \$ 988.00 and \$ 100.00 for a gate valve installed along Oakwood Drive. Motion was seconded by Morrison. Motion carried.

Motion by Metge and seconded by Friday that Sewer Commissioner, LeRoy Miller, be authorized to attend the Water Pollution Control Operators' Conference at Iowa City Nov. 17-18, 1969 with the same monetary allowance as allowed last year. The clerk also being directed to send in the registration fee of \$ 30.00. Motion carried.

The Council discussed the fees to be submitted at the next regular council meeting for the new ordinance making revisions for the Mayor, Councilmen and treasurers fees. Proposals agreed upon were as follows:

Mayor: \$ 400.00 per year effective January 1, 1972.

Councilmen: \$15.00 for regular Meeting attendance and \$10.00 for Special meeting attendance effective January 1, 1972.

Treasurer: \$ 200.00 per year effective January 1, 1970.

There being no further business evident it was moved and seconded to adjourn.
