Moved by Crouse seconded by Hesselhuus that we proceed to oil our streets as soon as possible. Motion prevailed.

Following Resolution was then presented and read:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CONRAD, IOWA:

That all of the Streets and Avenues within the corporate limits of the town are hereby ordered oiled and that the entire costs thereof, except the expense of oiling the intersections, shall be assessed to the abutting property according to the benefits conferred thereby. The Oiling to be done by the Municipality and the benefits assessed in accordance with the state law providing for the oiling of streets and assessing the costs to the abutting property benefited.

on motion of Crouse, seconded by Hesselhuus voting on the above resolution was done by calling the roll resulting in the following vote:

Ayes: Crouse, Newton, Hesselhuus, Brockway

Nays: None

Resolution was then declared adopted.

On motion of Newton, seconded by Crouse J. L. Hesselhuus was appointed to purchase Six (6) Rain Coats for the Firemen and Mayor Shoup directed Clerk Larson to order a dozen bottles of Chemicals for use of the fire brigade.

There being no dissenting voice on motion of Crouse seconded by Newton the Street Committee were instructed to care for the Drive Ways in the Cemetery when the same are in need of attention.
