Meeting was adjourned and regular meeting was continued in session.




Motion by Metge to approve the Beer License Application for the American Legion. Second by McLean. Carried.

Mayor Martin called for bids for the above described bonds. There were None.




Councilman Metge introduced the aboved resolution and moved its adoption. Councilman McLean seconded the motion to adopt. The RollCall Vote was,


