

The Council met in special session at the Municipal Building at 8:00 P.M. On call to order by Mayor Dale Friday, the following members were present: H. D. Martin, Keith Koehler, W. H. Simms. Absent: Dilman Daggett, Dr. Bert Combs.

Moved by Martin, seconded by Koehler, that the town contract Neiderhauser Airways to spray the town for insect control. Carried.

Moved by Koehler, seconded by Martin, that the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, there is now in the hands of the treasurer the sum of \$4586.98, credited to the General Government Fund, and \$4739.11 credited to the Utilities Fund, and

WHEREAS, it is desired to transfer \$1200.00 from the General Government Fund to the Street Fund, and \$2500.00 from the Utilities Fund to the Street Fund for the following reasons:

For the purpose of providing sufficient funds in the Street Fund to pay for the street repairs already contracted and completed and,

WHEREAS, said transfer is to be in accordance with Section 24.22, Code of Iowa; and,

WHEREAS, there is sufficient money in the General Government and Utilities Funds to meet all demands thereon; and

WHEREAS, all laws relating to municipalities have been complied with;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, of Grundy County, Iowa, subject to the approval of the State Comptroller, that said sum of \$1200.00 be, and the same is hereby transferred from the General Government Fund to the Street Fund, and \$2500.00 from the Utilities Fund to the Street Fund, and the Clerk is directed to correct his books accordingly and to notify the Treasurer of this transfer, ^{notification with a copy of this} accompanying the resolution and the record of its adoption. The vote thereon was as follows:

Ayes: Martin, Koehler, Simms.

Nays: None

Absent: Combs, Daggett.

Moved by Martin, seconded by Simms, that the Budget estimate as prepared be set for hearing on Aug. 5, 1957, at 8:00 P.M. at the Town Hall at Conrad, and that notice thereof be published in The Conrad Record, at least 10 days before the date of said hearing as required by law. Carried.

Moved by Koehler, seconded by Simms, that Council adjourn. Carried.
