

Conrad, Iowa
March 30, 1954

Council met in special session at the Town Hall: In the absence of Mayor Clapsaddle, the meeting was called to order by the clerk, at 7:30 P.M.

Bone, Combs, Martin, Schultz, Strickler answering the roll call.

Mayor Clapsaddle by a written notice appointed Councilman Martin as Mayor Pro-Tem. The Council approved this appointment.

And accepted his bonds.
Moved by Combs seconded by Schultz that the B plan be accepted as revised by discussion by the council.

On call vote: Bone, Combs, Schultz, and Strickler all voted Aye, Nays none.

Councilman Strickler introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption. Same was seconded by Councilman Combs.

" The following RESOLUTION was published in the Conrad Record on
APRIL 1st. 1954 "

" RESOLUTION "

Whereas there is need for an adequate fire station, town hall and library in the Town of Conrad, Iowa; and whereas there is not sufficient funds available to construct such a municipal building; and whereas if such a municipal building is to be constructed it will be necessary to contract indebtedness for the Town and issue bonds to pay for same,

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, that an election shall be called for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, the following proposition, to-wit:-

" Shall the Town of Conrad, Iowa, erect a building for use as fire station, town hall and library and contract indebtedness for such purpose not exceeding \$15,000.00 and issue bonds for such purpose not exceeding \$15,000.00 and levy tax annually upon the taxable property in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, not exceeding 5 mills per annum for payment of such bonds and the interest thereon?

that such election shall be held on the 22nd. day of April 1954, at the polling place in the fire station of the Town of Conrad, Iowa and the Town Clerk is hereby instructed to have published notice thereof once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Conrad Record, a newspaper published in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, the last publication thereof to be not less than five days nor more than twenty days before the date fixed for said election.

On roll call: Bone, Combs, Schultz, and Strickler all voted Aye. Nays none.

Whereupon Councilman Martin, Mayor Pro-tem than declared this resolution duly passed and adopted this the 30th. day of March A.D. 1954.

Notice is hereby given that on the 22 day of April, 1954, during the usual voting hours, an election will be held in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, the polling place being at the fire station therein, at which time and place the following proposition will be submitted:-

" Shall the Town of Conrad, Iowa, erect a building for use as fire station, town hall and library and contract indebtedness for such purpose not exceeding \$15,000.00 and issue bonds for such purpose not exceeding \$15,000.00 and levy tax annually upon the taxable property in the Town of Conrad, Iowa not exceeding 5 mills per annum
