The Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa
met on call of Mayer S.F.Price in the director rooms of
the Conrad State Bank.

Members present

E.O.Ecklund, L.G.Sherben, J.R.Gier, and B.F.Wilhelm

Absent

Mayer S.F.Price and Councilman E.M.Stark

On motion J.R.Gier acted as Mayor pro tem

Letter from Schanke & Co., was read in which they say they
cannot handle the Sewer and Water Bonds as per their agreement
but ask for an increase in the rate of $\frac{1}{2}$ per cent .

On motion of Ecklund and second of Sherben the contract with
Schanke & Co for the sale of the Sewer and Water bonds was
ordered cancelled

Mr.E.L.Guild Pres., on behalf of the Conrad State Bank
submitted a proposition for the purchase of the sewer and
water bonds as follows.

Will pay you the sum of \$15,000.00 for the water and sewer
bonds and pay all attorney's fees incurred by us providing we
are allowed. \$159.00 to pay part of the expense of the issue.

Ecklund moved and Sherben seconded that the offer of the
Conrad State Bank for the sewer and water bonds be accepted.

Carried.

Ecklund moved and Sherben seconded that the Clerk be authorized
to issue warrants in payment for material and tank in accordance
with contract with the Des Moines Bridge and Iron Co., pending
the settlement of the sale of the bonds with the Conrad State Bank

Carried.

On motion council adjourned.
