

Special Meeting
March 23, 1987

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Gearhart at 7:00 P.M.

There was a motion by Schiebel and second by King to set the bid letting for the '87 Street Project for April 13, 1987 at 7:30 P.M. Motion carried.

King made the motion to accept Bill Hartwig's bid of \$19,310. for labor and to change services on the water line on Church Street. Second by Schiebel. Carried.

Then Schiebel made a motion to send the materials list for that project to three suppliers and Gary Moler be authorized to accept the lowest bid. Second by King & carried.

Ed Bockman and John Cravens of R. G. Dickinson and Co. presented a proposal offering their services on the financing of capital improvements and interim financing during construction. The council made no decision at this time.

Dave Fox presented the council with two sets of Plans and Specifications to be on file at the City Hall and available for inspection by prospective bidders. He delivered the Notice of Hearing and Letting to be published in the Conrad Record.

Mayor Gearhart asked Fox that the number of manholes to be raised or lowered be specified in the contract.

Job interviews were held with Dave Colin, Tom Matt, Jim Gethmann and Brett Purvis.

After the interviews and some discussion the council agreed to hire Dave Colin for the combined job of city maintenance and police duty. He will be paid \$11,000 annually and \$6.50 per hour for week-end police duty. There will be a probation period until July 1, 1987 and at that time the annual salary becomes \$11,500. He will receive single medical insurance which includes \$10,000 life insurance. There will be one weeks vacation after one year worked and two weeks after two years. He will earn 1/2 day sick leave each month and may accumulate 15 days. There will be a cumulative uniform allowance of \$50. per year.

Mayor Gearhart presented a bid of \$3,990. for Mead Roofing to repair the roof over the City Hall and old fire station which is now the library. This will be discussed again at the April meeting.

Motion to adjourn by Schiebel. Second by King. Carried.
