Motion by King, second by Sanderson that the clerk be authorized to write a letter to Church Mutual Insurance Co. to release the demolition cost reserve held for the Assembly of God Church when appropriate. Motion carried.

King made a motion that the clerk write a letter to the real estate company and investigate the status of a property on Dwight and Grundy. Second by Sanderson. Carried.

King gave an update on the Community Center. The committee met on May 17th and have voted to remodel the facility. They will install two furnaces, paint walls & ceilings, professionally clean walls, light fixtures & kitchen, lay vinyl flooring & some carpet and purchase new tables and chairs at a cost of \$15,000.


The committee plans to have a fund drive and have the work completed by Black Dirt Days.

There was some discussion on lot lines being marked before a building permit is obtained for construction of a home or an addition. Also, some kind of a penalty if a structure is built too close to a lot line. The clerk will look into this while revising the building permits.
