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Motion by Curry, seconded by Daggett that bills be allowed. Carried.

Motion by Wilson, seconded by Manning to retain Mr. Don Kliebenstein as the Town Councils Legal Attorney with a retaining fee of twenty-five \$ 25.00) until January, 1, 1962 and fifty dollars (50.00) per year there after if the new council approves it. Motion carried.

The Council then met with various citizens of the community to hear their problems.

Don Martin, Chairman of the Citizens Committee presented a resolutions to the Town Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa for discussion and recommendations of the Council, urging the Council to conduct a cost study regarding the cost of storm sewers, grading of streets, curb and gutter guttering, paving, and any other necessary costs pertaining to the street improvement proposal in the Town of Conrad, Iowa.

Bessie Loverin and Mrs. Les Hoppenworth presented a petition with approximately three hundred (300) names asking the Council to take immediate action to eliminate the rust from the city water supply. WE approve of their spending the necessary amount of money to correct the Rusty Water Situation."

The Council assured them they had already contacted the firm and have made other inquiries.

Park Board Chairman, Ward Walter, representing the Commercial Club presented the financial problems arising from the summer band concerts.

Motion by Curry, seconded by Wilson that Les Carlin in addition to Public Safety Officers shall maintain and supervise the City Dump at a fee of Seventeen dollars fifty cents (17.50) per month. The hours will be the same. Tuesday and Saturday 12:30 to 3:30 P.M. Motion Carried.

Motin by Curry, seconded by Wilson to turn the books over to the present Town Clerk, Hazel Berry who assumes responsibility from July, 1, 1961. Motion Carried.

Beit ordained by the Council of the Town of conrad, Iowa that Section 35 of Ordinance #43 be amended as follows;

Amendment-

An amendment to Ordinance #43 entitled " An Ordinance Regulating the use of Streets, Alleys and Highways by Vehicles of all kinds and perscribing Penalties For Violation "

BE it Resolved by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Grundy County, Iowa that Section 35 of said Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following adoption in lieu thereof:

API356

Section 35

It shall be unlawful to stop or park a vehicle on the street unless the right side thereof is next to and parallel with the curb or curb line and as near thereto as the condition of the street will permit except on Main Street from Grundy Avenue to Walnut Street where "head in" parking at an angle of approximately sixty percent (60%) with the curb line; provided that the provisions of this section and all not apply in cases of emergency when the stop is made to avoid ~~acc~~ accident or to allow pedestrians or vehicles to cross in front of such vehicle, or when made in obedience to the signal of a Police Officer. It shall be unlawful to park or leave unattended any truck of over three-fourths (3/4) ton capacity on any street for a period of over eight (8) hours, or any other vehicle for a period of twenty-four (24) hours.

Motion by Curry, seconded by Manning that Section 35 Ordinance # 43 Amendment be adopted as stated. Carried
