

July 28, 1997

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 7-28-97 in Council Chambers. Members present: Dorothy King, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge, Ken Sanderson and Kevyn Zacharias. Also present was Helen Kopsa and Gary Sindalar. Absent: Denise Hoy, City Clerk. Mayor Gearhart called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Matt Tapken informed Council that the water tower has been filled and is up and running. Council voiced concerns on the exterior paint not matching on the water tower. Mayor Gearhart said he would check with John McNair to see if he could match the paint more closely. Tapken also reported that parking lines have been repainted on Main Street.


Council Member King reported that the Raskel's property settlement would be August 1, 1997.

~~Main~~ Center Sanderson reported that he had visited with Marv Moat's in regards to his property on Main Street. Sanderson said that Marv had made some progress on cleaning up the property. The dirt has been moved, he boarded up the house, mowed the weeds, and put poison in the basement. There was still concern from area neighbors on the appearance of the property. Councilman Sanderson will follow up with Moats on the standing dead weeds, and chunks of cement in the back yard.

Ryken presented a contract for the Industrial Park Road and also the sewer line project for Jennings and Walnut, but no action was taken at this time. Sindalar also reported that the plans for the sewer plant are 85 % done and will be submitted to the DNR for review. The review could take up to 120 days, and we should be ready to take bids in February 1998. Lutes is to contact the land owner, Glenn Hurlbutt, for land acquisition.

With no further business, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 8:50 p.m.
