 did enter into a contract with the Incorporated town of Conrad, Iowa,
 for the construction of an 8inch sewer, commencing at the intersection
 of Alice and Center Streets in said town and running thence east along
 the center line of said Center Street approximately 370 ft, to the
 center line of Lincoln Street. thence north on ^{the} center line of Lincoln
 Street approximately 430 ft, to the center line of Grundy Avenue.
 which contract was duly approved by this Town Council on the 23rd day
 of July 1923, and.
 WHEREAS, the said Paul Berg has fully completed the construction of
 said improvement, in accordance with the plan and specifications and
 contract therefor. as shown by the report of E A Crary, Engineer.
 filed with the Town Clerk on the 5th day of November 1923.
 NOW & THEREFOR, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of the Incorporated
 Town of Conrad, Iowa, thatthe said report of E A Crary. engineer, be
 hereby approved, and adoped, and that the improvement above described
 constructed under and by virtue of the said contract and the plans and
 specifications of the said contract and the plans and specifications
 therein referred to, and the total cost of said improvement is hereby
 determined to be \$768.44 as shown by said Engineers report.
 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by said Town Council, that said E A Crary,
 Engineer, is hereby instructed and directed to prepare a plat and scheM-
 dule of the property benefited by said improvement, showing the separate
 Lots and parcels of ground, or parts thereof, subject to assessment for
 the costs and expenses of the construction of said improvement, together
 with the names of the owners thereof, as far as practicable, and the
 amount assessable by law and the resolutions of this Council against
 each lot or parcel of ground abutting on said improvement, which said
 plat and schedule, when completed, shall be filed in the office of the
 Town Clerk.
