Moved by Burch seconded by Neuroth that bills be allowed and warrants drawn for same. Carried



Moved by Burch seconded by Bone that a truck load of pre-mixed material and one 55 gallon drum of asphalt be purchased from the Asphalt Paving Materials Co. in West Des Moines and Walt Neuroth's truck is to deliver same to Conrad. Carried.

Martin moved Bone seconded that Walt Neuroth's truck haul the gravel from the Conrad Gravel pit for graveling the west end of Grundy Avenue, Maple Avenue and Grant Street. Carried.

Moved by Burch seconded by Neuroth that the Council adjourn. Carried.

Council met at First State Bank of Conrad at 9 o'clock A.M. to receive bids for the \$13000.00 water bonds being issued by the town, pursuant to the provisions of the council at its meeting on May 8, 1950, with Ray Gravenstein, Mayor, and Councilmen B.B. Bone, H.D. Martin, Walter Neuroth, and D.C. Reece present. Absent H.L. Burch.

This being the time set for receiving bids for the \$13000.00 issue of water bonds, the council called for oral bids for said bonds; there being no written bids filed.

The First State Bank of Conrad, Iowa, bid \$13130.00 for said bonds and agreed in addition thereto to assume all expense in connection with the printing and legal expense in connection with said bonds. There being no other bids offered and that being a bid equal to the statutory requirement, it was moved by Councilman Reece seconded by Councilman Neuroth that the bid of the First State Bank of Conrad, Iowa, be accepted.

Roll being called, Councilmen Bone, Martin, Neuroth, Reece voted Aye. There being no nays, said motion was declared adopted and said bonds sold to said First State Bank of Conrad, Iowa.
