The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 8-26-02 in Council Chambers. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, LeAnn Lynch, and Steve Mugge. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and began with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

Mugge motioned and Lutes seconded to approve the final payment on Maple Avenue in the amount of \$17,687.62 and to fix the two-year warranty date to begin June 1, 2002. Ayes: Lutes, Lynch, Mugge, Callaway, Gearhart. Nays: none

Council appointed the Mayor to issue building permits in the absence of the Zoning Administrator.


Gearhart motioned and Mugge seconded to adopt resolution #118-8.02 "Declaring necessity and providing for notice of hearing on proposed revitalization plan". Ayes: Gearhart, Callaway, Mugge, Lynch, and Lutes. Nays: none. The hearing was set for 10/14/02 at 7:30 p.m.

Mugge motioned and Lynch seconded to set a hearing for 09/09/02 at 7:30 p.m. to consider the adoption of the updated Code of Ordinances. Ayes: 5.

Council discussed the parking on Main Street and Center Street and also on narrow Street throughout the City. No action was taken, and the resolution now in force will remain.

With no further business, meeting was adjourned by motion at 7:40 p.m.
