Treasurers July Report was read and approved as read.

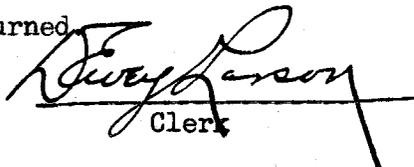
Following bills presented and on motion allowed and ordered

This meeting was called for the purpose of letting contract
for drilling a new well for the town.

Two bidders only were present presenting the following bids:
H.G.Taddiken of Conrad \$3.75 per foot he to furnish 8" wrought-
i-ron casing and steel shoe to first rock or \$2.85 per foot
the town to furnish the casing and steel shee.
Other bid was Hoag & Anderson of Lincoln his bid being .25¢
per foot higher than the Taddiken bid.

On motion the bid of H. G. Taddiken was accepted the work to
be started inside of ten days and to be completed inside of
thirty days.
