Immediately after the old Council adjourned, Mayor Gravenstein gave the oath of office to the new mayor Roy L. Clapsaddle.

Mayor Clapsaddle then called the new council to order and gave the oath of office to the new member of the council. B.B.Bone, H.L.Burch, H.D.Martin, Walter Neuroth, and H.E.Strickler being present.

Moved by Martin seconded by Bone that the meeting place for the council should be at the Town Hall on the first Monday of each month, and the time 7:30 P.M.

Moved by Burch seconded by Martin that H.D.Hunt be hired as Town Clerk for the ensuing twenty one months at a salary of \$50.00 per month. Payable monthly. carried

Mayor Clapsaddle appointed DR.R.T.Spain as health officer for the ensuing twenty-one months.Salary to be \$20.00 per year.

Mayor Clapsaddle appointed W.J.Duncan as Town marshall for the ensuing twenty-one months.Salary to be \$180.00 per month,pay-able monthly,said salary to include the care of the town dump, Town hall and fire truck.

Mayor Clapsaddle appointed R.C.Dickover as street commissioner and water superentendant.

Burch moved and Nuroth seconded that R.C.Dickover's salary be \$200.00 per month. The \$550.00 to be paid from the utilitie fund and \$145.00 to be paid from the General Government fund. carried

Martin moved and Bone seconded that bonds for Mayor Clapsaddle, Treasurer,Evelyn Stevens and Clerk,H.D.Hunt be accepted. carried

Martin moved and Neuroth seconded that the application for cigarette permit for Thorman's store be accepted. carried

Martin moved and Burch seconded that the application for cigarette permit for B.E.Bone's store be accepted. carried

Councilman Burch introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption.Same was seconded by Councilman Bone.

Resolution Naming Depository of Public Funds.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad,Grundy County,Iowa: That we do hereby designate the following named bank to be the depository of the town funds in the amounts not to exceed the amount named opposite said designated depository and the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to deposit the town funds in amounts not to exceed in the aggregate the amounts named for said bank as follows, to-wit:

First State Bank, Conrad,Iowa: Maximum Deposit under this Resolution; \$20,000.00

On call of roll, Councilmen Bone, Burch, Martin, Nuroth, and Strickler all voted "aye". Nays:none.
