Motion by Moler, second by Beeghly to accept the bid of Mid-Iowa Concrete and Construction of Wellsburg for the cement work on Grundy Ave. north of the Community Building, the off street parking area and the area between the Community Building and the fire station. The bid was \$1.10 per foot plus \$.10 for wire mesh.

A check of \$50. presented to the council by retiring member Phil McLean was again discussed. Maurice was consulted and it was agreed upon to purchase a tree to be planted south of the library.

Mr. and Mrs. Dick Anderson stated that they had a complaint concerning a ticket that was issued to their son. They were dissatisfied with the police dept. handling of the wrong time stated on the ticket. After much discussion the matter was dropped.

The clerk was instructed to deposit \$98,066.97, representing the amount in the '76 Street Assm't, '78 Street Assm't. #1, and '78 Street Assmt. #2 funds, in a passbook savings account at the First State Bank. The finance committee, treasurer and clerk will meet in the near future and determine if more of the city's funds can also be deposited in a savings account or Money Market certificate.

Some of the problem areas of the city streets were discussed. Mayor Schleisman will contact Smith Const. to make sure the work will be done before the centennial.

Motion by Zern, second by Lutes that a renewal of the Class C Liquor license for the RonDell Lounge be granted. Carried.

Motion by Moler, second by Zern that the following establishments be authorized cigarette permits for the period of July 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981: Corral, Casey's General Store, Charlies, Thorman's, Conrad Pharmacy, Oakwood, Schleisman DX and RonDell Lounge. Motion Carried.

Mayor Schleisman asked Bill Gearhart to contact Wellsburg and Gladbrook about entering the red fire truck in their centennial parades. Gearhart reported he would if the sanding of the truck was completed in time.

The council members were also asked by the Mayor to be available to ride in the Conrad Centennial parade on July 5th.

It was reported by Beeghly that the light on top of the police car was out of order. He stated that a new strobe light installed would cost \$640.00. Motion by Lutes, second by Moler that a new strobe light be purchased. Carried.

Steve Sawyer of Corning Labs gave their monthly status report. Among the things discussed were alternatives for hauling sludge in the future, a new pump versus a new line to replace the one that plugs at the sewage treatment plant and the new contract that Corning will present to the city in September. Sawyer also stated that tests will be run at Ritchie Industries the week of June 16th to check for the presence of zinc and that he would get the report to the City as soon as possible.
