Moved by Frederick and second by Belz that the marshal see Mrs Jas, Young in regard to having fence removed and alley open, Carried,

Moved by Frederick and second by Marks that the water commettee be Authorized to adjust water trouble with the school bord, Carried,

Moved by Belz and second by Gier that the following resolution be Adoped Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Conrad Iowa. That the proposed assessments of the cost of oiling, Main street from The north Incorapated line hence 4280 feet south. and center street From Alice street hence west 200 feet west of the C. NW RR right away, Prepared by the clerk, which is now on file in his office ,

And notice of which , in compliance with the law, was given all person Liable for such assessments, be and the same is hereby levied aganst The property in accordancewith such proposed assessments, and all Such assessments not paid within thirty days after the passage of this Resolution shall be certified by the clerk to the county auditor As a special tax, aganst the property,
