

September 24, 2001

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 09/24/01 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll call was Bill Gearhart, Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge and Lloyd Weber. Absent: Shauna Callaway. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order and began with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 p.m.

A resolution received from the Grundy County Engineer setting a 35 mph speed limit on South Main Street was tabled. Council would like to check on making the speed limit at 45 mph instead of the suggested 35 mph.

Council received contracts for the Maple Avenue Water Main Project. Legal Council will be asked to review the contracts prior to adopting them. Action will be taken at the next regular meeting.

The agreement and contracts for fire protection and emergency response services between the City of Conrad and the Townships in our service area were discussed. The exact areas served in Melrose and Palermo Townships needs to be determined before contracts can be presented. A joint meeting between Melrose and Palermo Township Trustees, the Conrad Fire Department and Council representatives will be scheduled to discuss which sections of these townships Conrad Fire Department should cover. Contracts will then be entered into for fire protection services.

Under other business, council discussed moving a culvert on Duesenberg Drive and reworking some drive entrances on Center Street into alleys. Bruce Marble was instructed to check with BDL Contractors to see if they would have time to do the work.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 8:05 p.m.
