The Resolution was declared adopted and is as follows:-

RESOLUTION.

Whereas, there has been presented to the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa, a petition signed by qualified electors of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, requesting said Council to call a special election to give the qualified electors of said town an opportunity to vote on the proposition of bonding said Town in the sum of \$10,000.00 for the purpose of installing the necessary water works in said town and bonding said town in the sum of \$5,000.00 for the purpose of installing, purchasing, erecting and building the necessary sewer, sewer outlet or sewer disposal plant in said Town;

and,
 Whereas, said petition is signed by a majority of the qualified electors of said town; and,
 Whereas, as appears from said petition, neither the necessary water works nor the necessary sewer, sewer outlet or sewer disposal plant can be erected, built, furnished, purchased or installed within the limit of one and one fourth per cent of the actual value of the taxable property of said Town;
 Now, Therefore, Be it resolved by the Town Council of the Incorporated Town of Conrad, Iowa,

That a special election of the qualified voters of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, be and the same is hereby ordered to held in the Town Hall in the Town of Conrad, Iowa, on the 20 day of April 1917, at which election there shall be submitted to the vote of the qualified electors of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, the following proposition, viz:-

For the issuance of bonds in the sum of \$10,000.00 for water works purposes

Against the issuance of bonds in the sum \$10,000.00 for water works purposes.

For the issuance of bonds in the sum of \$ 5,600.00 for sewer purposes.

Against the issuance of bonds in the sum of \$ 5,000.00 for sewer purposes.

And the clerk is hereby directed to give legal notice of such special election as by law provided.

J.R.Gier moved that further action on the Resolution of Necessity be deferred to our next regular meeting seconded by L.G.Sherbon Carried.
