

February 25, 2002

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 02/25/02 at the Conrad City Hall. Answering roll call was Steve Mugge, Shauna Callaway, LeAnn Lynch, and Bill Gearhart. Absent: Robert Lutes. Mayor Sanderson called the meeting to order and began with the pledge of allegiance at 7:00 p.m.

Betty Wood discussed with Council the option of not being a Certified Local Government. She stated that the only repercussion of not being a CLG would be that Conrad would not be eligible for grants for city owned historical sites. Wood stated that the HPC Board would like to focus their efforts exclusively on the Museum. Council would need to change the ordinance that establishes the HPC and make them a Museum board. Council Member Gearhart instructed the City Clerk to draft a letter from the Mayor to decertify the City of Conrad as a CLG participant, Mugge seconded. Ayes: 4.


Gary Moler discussed with council the need for sewer main maintenance on Dwight Street. He currently had Dwight Street, between the blocks of Lillian and Maple televised which showed no blockage, but a couple of small problems that need to be repaired. Gearhart will look at the video and reports and make recommendations to council at the next meeting. Gearhart also discussed implementing a maintenance program for annual cleaning of the sewer mains.

Council reviewed and discussed the fiscal year 2003 budget. Mayor Sanderson then set the budget hearing for March 11, 2003 at 7:00 P.M.

Mayor Sanderson signed a proclamation setting February through March of 2002 as Daffodil Days in support of the American Cancer Society.

With no further business evident, meeting was adjourned in a motion at 7:55 P.M.
