The following Resolution was offered by Councilman Newton, Be it Resolved by the Council of the Town of Conrad, Iowa, that all of the Streets and Avenues with in the Incorporated Town of Conrad Iowa, be and the same is hereby orderd Oiled, and the entire costs there of, except the costs of oiling the intersections, shall be assessed to the property abutting upon such streets in proportion to the benefits conferred thereby, oiling shall be done by the Municipality, and the benefits assessed in accordance with the law providing for the oiling of streets and assessing the costs to the benefited property, the said resolution was adopted by the Aye and Nay Vote, *moved by Frederick and seconded by Wilhelm that the said resolution be passed* Newton Aye, Wilhelm Aye, Dostal Aye, Wheeler Aye, Belz Absent, The Mayor declared the resolution adopted, Moved by Wilhelm and seconded by Newton that there be posts obtained and be placed where needed at the sewer pit, Carried. Moved and seconded that we adjourn, Carried.
