

January 24, 2000

The Conrad City Council met in regular session on 1/24/00 in Council Chambers. The meeting was called to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was said. Answering roll call was Shauna Callaway, Lisa Purvis, and Lloyd Weber. Absent: Robert Lutes, Steve Mugge.

Council heard several budget request for the fiscal year 2000-2001 including: Main Street, Inc. \$10,000 plus in kind assistance with rent and utilities, Cemetery Assoc. \$1500, Operation Threshold \$500, Grundy County Development Alliance \$2892, Chemical Dependency Center \$1500. The council will consider each request.

Mayor Sanderson appointed Lisa Purvis to serve a three year appointment on the Conrad Main Street Board.

Bob Klein reviewed the cities insurance coverages with Council. Council instructed Klein to remove all equipment and buildings at the old sewer plant site. Weber was appointed to review in detail the property coverages and inland marine.

Mayor Sanderson reported that the street light committee had met and will have more details at a future meeting.

Mayor Sanderson proclaimed February 24, 2000 to be "Marie Miller" day in observance of her 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday.


Motion by Weber, seconded by Purvis to approve a liquor license for the American Legion Post 681. Ayes: 3.

Motion by Weber, seconded by Callaway to adopt resolution #101-1.00 "A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SAFETY PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF CONRAD, IOWA INCLUDING ALL DEPARTMENTS, EMPLOYEES AND CONTRACTORS WORKING FOR THE CITY." Ayes: Weber, Callaway, Purvis.

Council discussed briefly the issue of snowmobiles in Conrad. Council will review the ordinance and inform the Grundy County Deputy Mike McAteer of complaints.

Purvis motioned and Weber seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 p.m.
